**DEACON'S DESK:** Jonathan Safran Foer is an American novelist. He is best known for his novels Everything Is Illuminated, Extremely Loud & Incredibly

Close. He once said:

"Not responding is a response - we are equally responsible for what we don't do."

As we enter this most important phase of our capital campaign for "Re-Igniting Our Faith" we should be pausing to pray for our response to the appeal. It is about funding programs that are beyond our Parish boarders and benefit the larger Church of Albany, our Diocese, priestly vocations, evangelization, priest retirement, and Catholic education. It is also about embracing a new vision for our Parish, and the urgency that surrounds it.

Funding will be for our worship space, to bring it back to its natural beauty, and make it more comfortable for our parishioners, both young and old. Funding will also be for our Parish House, a new roof, and, very important, for McManus: a new roof, a new gym floor for our youth, and an elevator to make it fully accessible in our day and age.

Our Scriptures this weekend challenge us for a response. Jonah preaches repentance to the Ninevites, and their response is their salvation. Jesus invites Simon and Andrew, James and John, and their response is the Kingdom of God. Paul calls us to respond to these times, which are now different from the past. New things are coming! Christ, raised from the dead, is the new reality we all share in. What is our response?

Imagine saying no, or imagine just ignoring it. What sort of life would we have. We are living in a world that is ever in motion, always changing, and never the same. Look around. No response is not an option. We have the opportunity to say "Yes!" to a vision of the Church that is new and vibrant, engaging our world where our world lies. Like the apostles, sacrifice is called for. We join with them committing a portion of our treasure to Christ and the Church, for a better life for our children and their children to come.
