A "Eucharistic Congress" is a special gathering led by the Bishop focused on our Lord Jesus in the Eucharist. It is a time of joy, fellowship, prayer, and unity. Deacon's Desk: This saint was recommended to me, but may become one of my favorites. St. Herman of Alaska - Wonderworker of All America

St. Herman was born in 1756, in the city of Serpukhov, in the Diocese of Moscow. He entered the Trinity-Sergius Hermitage at the age of 16. While there, he suffered from an abscess of the throat, so severe, it was difficult to swallow. Praying to Mary, and near death, he was cured overnight.

After several years at Valaamo Monastery, as the Russian Empire expanded to Alaska, in 1793 Fr. Herman was asked to join in a mission to teach the Gospel message to the native Alaskan tribes. They met much success with thousands converting to Christianity. A church, school and monastery was built to establish the Orthodox faith in America. As his mission grew, he centered the order on Spruce Island in the Kodiak Archipelago, with the name New Valaamo. First living in a hand dug cave, he would eventually have built wooden chapel and house. Living alone, it would be his home for forty years until his death.

Fr. Herman lived the simple life of a monk, working a garden, in prayer, fasting, and spreading the faith. His diet were fish and garden vegetables. His clothes were the same year-round. He ministered to the needs of the local natives, either spiritual or physical, and interceded for them with the local Russian governor and worked tirelessly during an influenza epidemic that killed dozens. His prayers protected the monastery and natives from a wildfire that struck the island. When a flood threatened the island, he placed an icon of the Blessed Virgin on the beach, and after praying to Mary, the waters stopped before reaching the image. His prayers are attributed to the healing of many gravely ill natives.

He build a school and orphanage for the Aluet children and administered the sacraments faithfully. He was well respected for his holiness and preaching. He continued to minister to the people for the rest of his life and on December 25, 1836, he passed away and was buried in the original cave he dug as his first home. Today, pilgrims continue to journey to Spruce Island to visit the hermitage, chapel and tomb of St. Herman of Alaska, the patron saint of the Orthodox Church in America.
