
2018 - 19 Budget Report to the Parish

Description of Line Items (Not inclusive of all Items):

Regular Sunday Collection – This is the total amount given through the regular Sunday envelopes.

All Other Collection - This includes all other envelopes such as Fuel, Holy Days and Capital Campaign.

Other Income – This amount covers receipts for funerals, candles, interest and rental income.

Other Income – Assessable This amount is for Masses, donations, Mother's and Father's Day envelopes

Other Income – Non-Assessable This amount includes any gains or losses on investments and all other income

Salaries & Benefits This amount is the salaries and benefit costs for our Parish staff, excluding the cemetery.

Office Expense & Supplies This covers the cost of supplies for the Church and offices, including bookkeeping costs, telephone and postage.

Utilities, R & M This covers our heat, water and sewer, insurances, repairs and maintenance costs for our buildings and trash pickup.

Support Services This is our costs for the Evangelist subscriptions, liturgical publications, hymnals, retreats, trainings, transportation and printing.

Charity Donations This is the amount we donate to our local charities.

School Assessment & Misc. This is our bank fees, payroll charges, investment fees, Diocesan School Assessment, miscellaneous charges and Bishop's Appeal Assessment shortfall payment.

Equipment & Repair This would be any capital costs, such as new equipment or work done on the Parish roofs or buildings in general

Contingency - A required item equal to about 4% of the total expenses to be used in case of emergencies only. It does not show up on any end of the year statement.

Weekly Goal (To meet our current needs): What is needed to cover all our parish costs through the regular collection. This reflects the parish health and ability to meet its needs without other income.

Deacon's Desk:

ST. AIBERT OF CRESPIN, OSB

Today we journey back to the Middle Ages of Northern Europe. It was a time known for its mystics and recluses.

Aibert (or Aybert) was born in 1060, in the village of Espain, in the Diocese of Tournai, in what is today modern Belgium. His father was a knight, Sir Aldbad of Espen.

Moved to a life of ascetic living after hearing a traveling minstrel sing a hymn of St. Theobald, and under the direction of the hermit John of Crespin, Aibert lived an austere life, fasting frequently while working in the fields. According to his biographer Robert, Archdeacon of Oostrevand, "they chose to eat neither foods of animal origins, nor foods that had been cooked."

After a pilgrimage to Rome in 1090, he entered the Benedictine order, where he spent 25 years as provost and cellarer at the Crespin Abby. In 1115 he was allowed to return to the life of a hermit, constructing a hermitage in the wilderness. Known for his holiness, he was constantly sought out for healing and spiritual advice.

Shortly after his return to the solitary life, he was ordained to the priesthood by Bishop of Cambrai so he may celebrate Mass and hear confessions. Aibert is noted for celebrating two masses a day, one for the living and one for the dead. His devotion to the Rosary was profound and is said to have prayed it many times a day with genuflections and prostrations.

St. Aibert died in 1140 at the age of 80. His feast day is April 7th.
