Deacon's Desk: "If God is in a life, it doesn't have to be big to be happy and to be important in His kingdom."

We see the contrast in today's Gospel from John. Pilate, who felt power and strength, and Jesus, humble and stricken. Yet God's life was in Him. We do not know the same of the Roman.,

On this Feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe we honor the King who would reveal glory and honor in a whole different light. Power, majesty, strength and glory as we know it in this life have no meaning in the life to come. They are useless human ideals in the eyes of God. To be of the Kingdom is to follow Jesus in simplicity and humility. Like Jesus who did not seek equality with God something to grasp onto, but rather emptied Himself to be servant for all.

To think then, of Kingship and Kingdom in human terms is to completely miss the grandeur of God's Kingdom. Pilate did, because he was looking for something he could understand, but could not recognize the presence of true power and glory right in front of him. We don't need to seek prominence or to hold stature as a member of the Kingdom. Jesus as King models for us the one who would subject himself to the will of God. As we conclude our liturgical year with this great feast, we place ourselves at the feet of Jesus, humbled, yet filled with joy and hope to find our place in His Kingdom for all time.
